



Great Transport Connections



- 17-minute train journey to Central London, trains every 3 to 5 minutes
- Underground - District Line
- Local trams, buses, taxis
- 24-hour links from central London: night bus from Trafalgar Square to Wimbledon
- 24 hour underground to South Wimbledon station on Fridays & Saturdays.
- WSE is a 3-minute walk from the train/underground/tram station
- Wimbledon is in Zone 3 of London's 6 zones
- *All the advantages of London and none of the stress!*








