Victoria is home to numerous events and festivals including the Victoria Film Festival, the Classic Boat Festival, and the TD Victoria International Jazz Fest.




Victoria has the mildest weather in Canada, with an average of +25° C in the summer and +9° C in the winter.

ENGLISH FOR ACADEMIC PURPOSES (EAP)





English for Academic Purposes (EAP) is an intensive program designed to prepare GV Pathway students to succeed at a Canadian college or university.

The EAP program focuses on strengthening general language skills, especially in advanced level communication skills and academic reading and writing skills. The program also covers essay writing, research papers, study skills, note-taking, presentations and research.

As part of the program, regular meetings with the Pathway Advisor are scheduled.

These meetings will not only review academic progress on the pathway, but can also cover the application process and communication with the college/university to ensure a successful transfer.

Institutions accept an IELTS exam score as proof of English proficiency.



COLLEGE & UNIVERSITY PATHWAYS

Below are some of the different credentials that you can earn at one of our Pathway institutions in Canada:

Diploma:	Requires completion of a two or three-year career, technical or vocational program.			
Associate Degree:	Requires completion of a program consisting of 20 university transfer courses.			
Bachelor's Degree:	Requires completion of an advanced-level, four-year specialized program.			
Post-Degree Diploma:	Requires completion of a specialized program which builds on a previously completed recognized degree. No minimum score is needed for entry. Takes 1 – 2 years. Popular specializations: Psychology, Nursing, Marketing, Advertising, and Public Relations			
Master's Degree:	Requires completion of a specialized program which builds on a previously completed recognized degree. Usually, a minimum score in undergrad studies is needed for entry. In Canada, your master's studies can include a thesis, practicum, research paper or a course-based program. Takes 2-3 years. Popular specializations: IT & Computer Science, Pharmacy, Nursing, Business Administration, Veterinary Medicine


